Official Rules

THIS SEABOURN CRUISE LINE SWEEPSTAKES AT THE 2024 MIAMI OPEN ("SWEEPSTAKES") IS GOVERNED BY THESE OFFICIAL RULES. BY PARTICIPATING IN THE SWEEPSTAKES, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ALL OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS STATED HEREIN. THIS SWEEPSTAKES IS INTENDED FOR PLAY IN THE UNITED STATES ("U.S.") AND CANADA ONLY (EXCLUDING QUEBEC) AND WILL BE GOVERNED BY U.S. AND CANADIAN LAW. DO NOT ENTER IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE AND LOCATED IN THE U.S. OR CANADA AT TIME OF ENTRY.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Seabourn Cruise Line Sweepstakes at the 2024 Miami Open (the "Sweepstakes") is only open to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia, and Canada (excluding Quebec), who have reached 21 years of age or older as of March 1, 2024. Void elsewhere, in Quebec and where prohibited. All employees of Seabourn Cruise Line Limited ("Sponsor"), its advertising and promotion agencies, and each of their respective parent companies, divisions, affiliates, subsidiaries, or agents (collectively, "Sweepstakes Entities") and their immediate families (defined as spouse, child, sibling, parent, or grandparent; whether biological, adopted, step or in-law) or household members are not eligible. 2. **HOW TO ENTER:** Sweepstakes entry period begins at 12:00 a.m. Pacific Time (PT) on March 1, 2024 and ends at 11:59 p.m. PT on April 12, 2024 (the "Entry Period"). To enter online, visit www.SeabournMiamiOpenSweepstakes.com (the "Sweepstakes Website") and follow the on-screen entry instructions to provide your full name, mailing address, date of birth and email address (which must remain the same throughout the Sweepstakes, including the prize awarding/verification period. There is a limit of one Sweepstakes entry per person and per e-mail address. Individuals may not enter more than once using a different email address. Sponsor reserves the right to void all entries made through any script, macro, robotic, automatic, mechanical, programmed or similar duplication method. Any attempt by the entrant to enter more than the number of times authorized herein, using multiple names and/or email addresses, and/or systematically entering from the same IP address, and/or any other fraudulent mechanism, as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion, shall give the Sponsor the right to disqualify the entrant in Sponsor's reasonable discretion. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, damaged, or misdirected entries, whether caused by entrants, or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Sweepstakes or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of the entries in the Sweepstakes. Sponsor is not responsible for any failure of the Sweepstakes Website during the Sweepstakes Period, including any technical malfunction of any computer online systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any email or entry to be received on account of traffic congestion on the Internet or at the Sweepstakes Website, or any combination thereof including any injury or damage to an entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from downloading any material related to the Sweepstakes, all of which may affect a person's ability to participate in the Sweepstakes. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion to modify, cancel or suspend this Sweepstakes should fraud, virus, bugs or other causes beyond the control of Sponsor corrupt the administration, security or proper play of the game. In the event of cancellation, Sponsor will randomly award the prize from among all eligible, non-suspect entries received prior to cancellation. Should a dispute arise regarding the identity of the entrant, the authorized account holder of the e-mail account at the time of entry will be considered the entrant. "Authorized account holder" is defined as the natural person who is assigned an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider or other organization which is responsible for assigning e-mail addresses or the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Any potential Winner may be requested to provide Sponsor with proof that such potential Winner is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the winning entry.
3. **WINNER SELECTION:** One potential winner will be determined in a random drawing on or around April 13, 2024, at 450 3rd Avenue West, Seattle, WA 98119, from among all eligible entries received during the Entry Period. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. Sponsor's decisions are final and binding in all respects. In order to be declared a winner, if a Canadian resident is selected as the potential winner, such Canadian resident must correctly answer a time limited mathematical skill-testing question ("Canadian Skill Question"). The potential winner will be notified by email on or about April 14,

2024 (“Winner Notification”). The Winner Notification will include an Affidavit/Declaration of Eligibility, Liability Release, Publicity Release (where legal) and information on the Canadian Skill Question if potential winner is a Canadian resident (collectively “Prize Verification Documents”). Such Prize Verification Documents must be completed, signed, notarized (if so directed) and returned within five (5) business days of Winner Notification send date. If the Winner Notification or prize or any prize correspondence is returned as non-deliverable; or if any required Prize Verification Documents are not completed, signed and returned within the time framed required; or if potential winner is determined to be ineligible or otherwise not in compliance with these Official Rules; or if potential Canadian winner fails to correctly answer the Canadian Skill Question, such potential winner may be disqualified and forfeit any claim to the prize. In such case, Sponsor reserves the right but not the obligation to award the prize to an alternate winner selected at random from the remaining eligible entries, and follow the same winner verification process set forth herein. One verified, the potential winner shall be referred to as the “Winner.”

Prize includes an air credit for use on Sponsor’s FlightEase system to book coach class flights to/from major airport nearest Winner’s home to major airport nearest Cruise departure port, up to a maximum of \$2,000.00 (USD)/\$2,695.00 (CAD) if flight is less than maximum available, no credit will be awarded for excess, nor may Winner upgrade to a higher class of airfare.
 - b. Option 2: a seven (7) day/six (6) night Mediterranean Marvels & Matches: Barcelona Open cruise departing from port in Rome, Italy on April 13, 2025 and returning to port in Barcelona, Spain on April 20, 2025, plus tickets for two to attend the Barcelona Open on April 19, 2025 while cruise is in port in Barcelona. Prize includes an air credit for use on Sponsor’s FlightEase system to book coach class flights to/from major airport nearest Winner’s home to major airport nearest Cruise departure port, up to a maximum of \$2,000.00 (USD)/\$2,695.00 (CAD) if flight is less than maximum available, no credit will be awarded for excess, nor may Winner upgrade to a higher class of airfare.

For either Cruise option, the Winner and his/her guest must travel together on the same itinerary. The Cruise consists of accommodations in a single suite for the Winner and one (1) guest. The suite category will be determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. All regular meals, standard beverages and onboard entertainment, as well as taxes, government fees and port expenses associated with cruise fare are included in the Prize. Any other expenses and costs associated with the acceptance or use of the Prize that are not expressly specified in these Official Rules as being part of the Prize, including without limitation, ground transportation to/from port, hotel accommodations, shore excursions, travel insurance, laundry service, spa

Cruise winners are NOT eligible for Seabourn's SeabournShield program. The Cruise must be booked at least forty-five (45) days prior to the intended travel dates. Actual dates of the Cruise are subject to availability and certain other restrictions, as determined in Sponsor's sole discretion. If the Winner's guest is under age 21, he or she must be accompanied in the same suite by Winner, who must be the parent/guardian of such guest if guest is a minor, and who assumes responsibility for his/her care. The Winner and guest are responsible for providing proper citizenship documentation to travel, which may include passports, valid alien registration card and/or necessary visas. Those without proper citizenship documentation will be denied boarding. Each traveler must check with his/her travel agent, government agencies, embassies or consulates prior to their vacation to ensure that they have proper citizenship documentation. U.S. Citizens can also visit the State Department's travel website at www.travel.state.gov or call the U.S. National Passport Information Center at (877) 4USA-PPT for more information. The prize will be awarded provided it is validly claimed by the date specified in the prize award notification. All travel is subject to any and all restrictions instituted by the United States Department of Defense and/or Department of Homeland Security or Canada's Department of National Defence, as required.

The approximate retail value ("ARV") of the Prize is \$17,000 USD / \$22,967 CAD. Prize values are based on conversion rates as of February 15, 2024 and may vary. The actual value of the prize depends which Cruise is selected and the point of departure of the flight, as well as on market conditions at time of fulfillment. Winner must provide any requested information needed for tax reporting, including as applicable a Form W-9 if a bearer is a US Citizen or resident, or Form W-8 if eligible non-US citizen or non-US resident, and understands that such information must be received Sponsor before or at

the time Cruise is booked. If Winner is a U.S. resident, he/she will receive IRS Form 1099 for the ARV of prize. Canadian residents may be subject to withholding taxes, and Canadian residents are responsible for the reporting and payment of any income tax.
